**COMMUNITY INFORMATION SESSION AND PUBLIC MEETING
ELCON RECYCLING SERVICES**

On February 23, 2016, Elcon Recycling Services, LLC (Elcon) is hosting a community information session and public meeting on the company's proposed plans to site a commercial facility for treatment of hazardous liquid waste streams. The site address is 100 Dean Sievers Place in the Keystone Industrial Port Complex (the former US Steel property) in Falls Township, PA. These plans will be part of Elcon's Part B application to the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection.

The Elcon USA facility will use environmentally sustainable technology that transforms liquid waste streams into usable clean water. Elcon's innovative technology is more eco-friendly than other liquid waste treatment technologies on the market today because zero liquid waste is discharged by the process and significantly lower solid waste is generated. The organic waste is transformed into energy that is sustainably used in the process.

Elcon's technology is not an incinerator, and it will not use solid or liquid waste incineration. Hazardous air pollutant emissions will be controlled through a thermal oxidizer to meet the federal EPA and Pennsylvania's air regulations.

The purpose of this meeting is to inform the community of Elcon's plans, to seek public input and to provide Elcon with an opportunity to respond directly to questions from the community about its plans. Interested members of the public can attend anytime between 6 p.m. and 9 p.m. to ask questions and provide their input on the project. Information boards, maps and graphics will be on hand during the community information session portion of the meeting, allowing the public to review Elcon's plans and talk one-on-one with Elcon's project team at their convenience. The formal presentation will start at 7 p.m., followed by a public question/input period. *All persons needing special access to the meeting should contact Elcon at least 72 hours prior to the meeting.*
